- Separate unaltered, haltered, and youth shows on Saturday and Sunday. Shows begin at 9am with pee-wee, youth, haltered, & unaltered.
- Saturday's judge Shadow Seaman, Sunday's judge Joel Dickinson (youth show judges still pending)
- Fairgrounds available after 1 on Friday, June 24. ALL cattle must be in place by 8am Saturday June 30. Cattle excused at the conclusion of each day's events.
- Entry fee - \$35 per class per day. Youth show entries – free
- Prizes (haltered & unaltered) – Buckles for All-Age Champions & All-Age Reserves, Ribbons for all placings
- Bring your own bedding and hay – straw and shavings OK but no chips. You are responsible for cleaning out your pens after the show.
- Health requirements – Maryland residents must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within the last 60 days. All other states must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within the past 30 days. ALL exhibitors must also complete the LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS SELF-CERTIFICATION OF ANIMAL HEALTH and have it with your cattle at the show.
- The name of the youth exhibitor must be listed on the youth show entry form. This exhibitor can be changed at the show if another eligible youth member wishes to show the entered animal.
- Pregnancy palpation information must be listed on the veterinary health certificates. If this information is not on the health certificate it will not be included on the judge's cards.
- CTLR and TLBAA registered cattle are eligible for this show but must pay an additional \$5 entry fee per entry per day. Exhibitors are not required to be NETLA or ITLA members but membership is welcomed.
